REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 8 OF 2024

REJECTION OF DOCUMENTS AND FILING FEES

1. An application or document filed in E-Services which does not comply with the Muslim Marriage and Divorce Rules, Practice Directions or Registrar's Circulars may be rejected by the Court Registry.
2. The Court Registry may also reject the filing of any document in any of the following circumstances:
 - (a) the filing of the document has been returned in the same filing transaction three times or more, and the requirements set out by the Registry in the returned remarks have not been complied with in full;
 - (b) three months or more have lapsed from the date of filing, and the requirements set out by the Registry in the returned remarks have not been complied with in full; or
 - (c) a request for payment waiver of filing fees is rejected and the filing fees for the transaction remain unpaid one month after the rejection.
3. There shall be no refund of any fee paid for an application or document which is rejected, or for any application or document which is returned and for which the filing transaction is not completed for any reason.
